Event Purpose

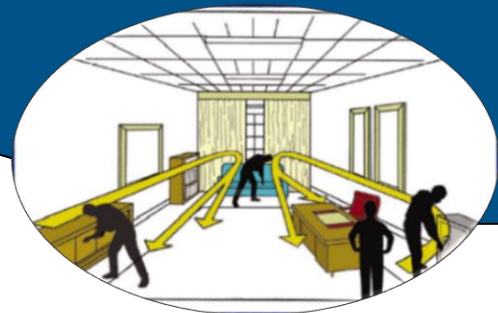
